Heather Heyer dedicated her life to standing up for those she felt were not being heard, her family and friends said. She died fighting for her beliefs and campaigning against hate.

Gov. Terry McAuliffe praised Heyer. "She was doing what she loved," McAuliffe said. "She was fighting for democracy, (for) free speech, to stop hatred and bigotry." Heather worked as a paralegal for a Charlottesville law firm, and had a special affinity for those in need of legal advice/assistance.
